## 10-frame Number Posters

This is a set of number posters, 2 to a page. The size is perfect when you are short on wall space, or you need a large flashcards size for a group lesson.

Includes 20 number posters showing the numeral and the appropriate 10-frame.

Children can:

- Recognize and name the number on each card
- Count the dots and relate the total to the number on each card
- Arrange cards in number order, ascending and descending
- Choose which card shows more or fewer when comparing 2 cards.
- Place small themed manipulatives to match the dots on each card
- Practice addition and subtraction

Teachers can:

- Print on cardstock and laminate for longest use
- Post on the wall
- Use as large flashcards for games and pocket charts
