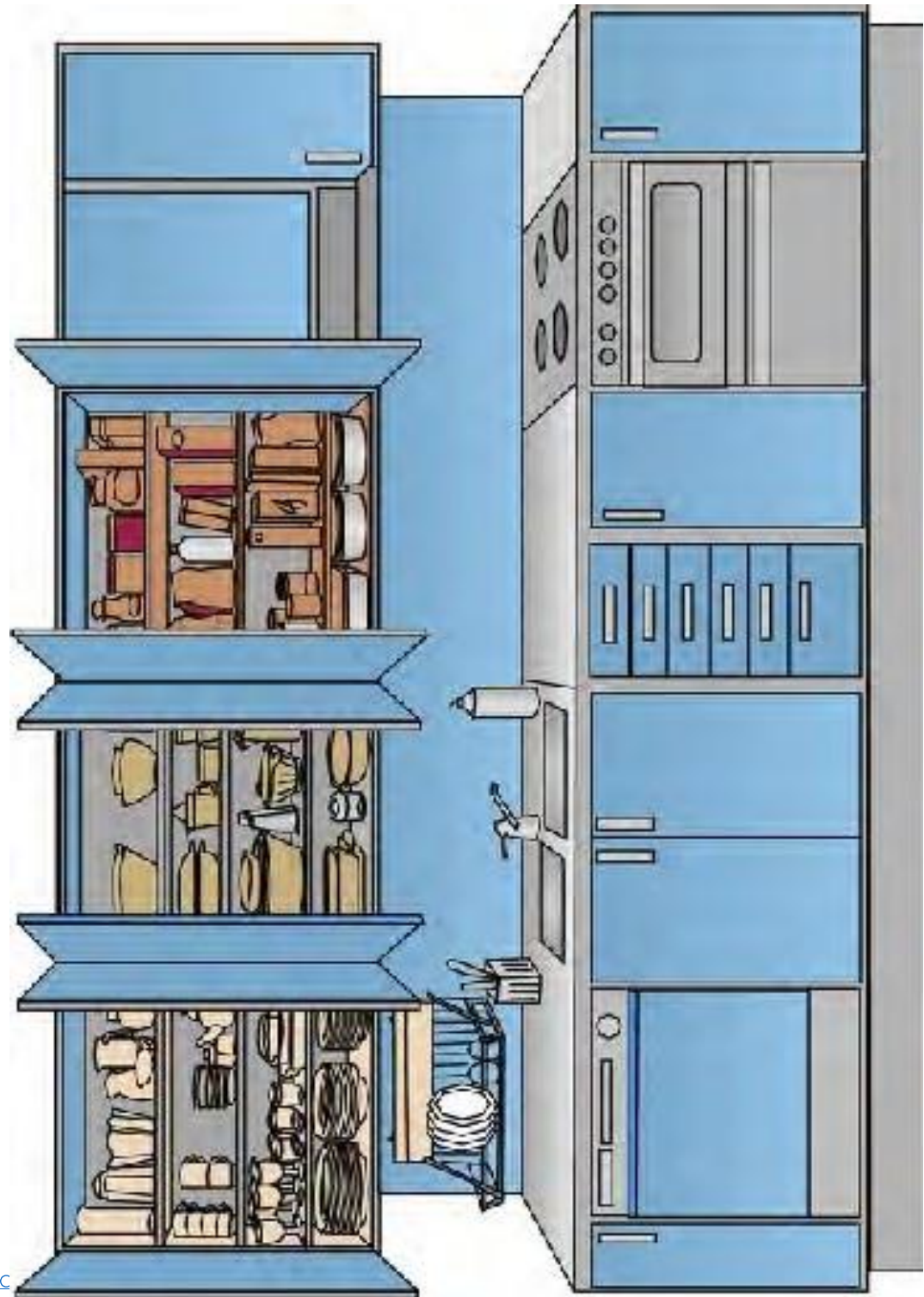
LetterK Bracelet Bands

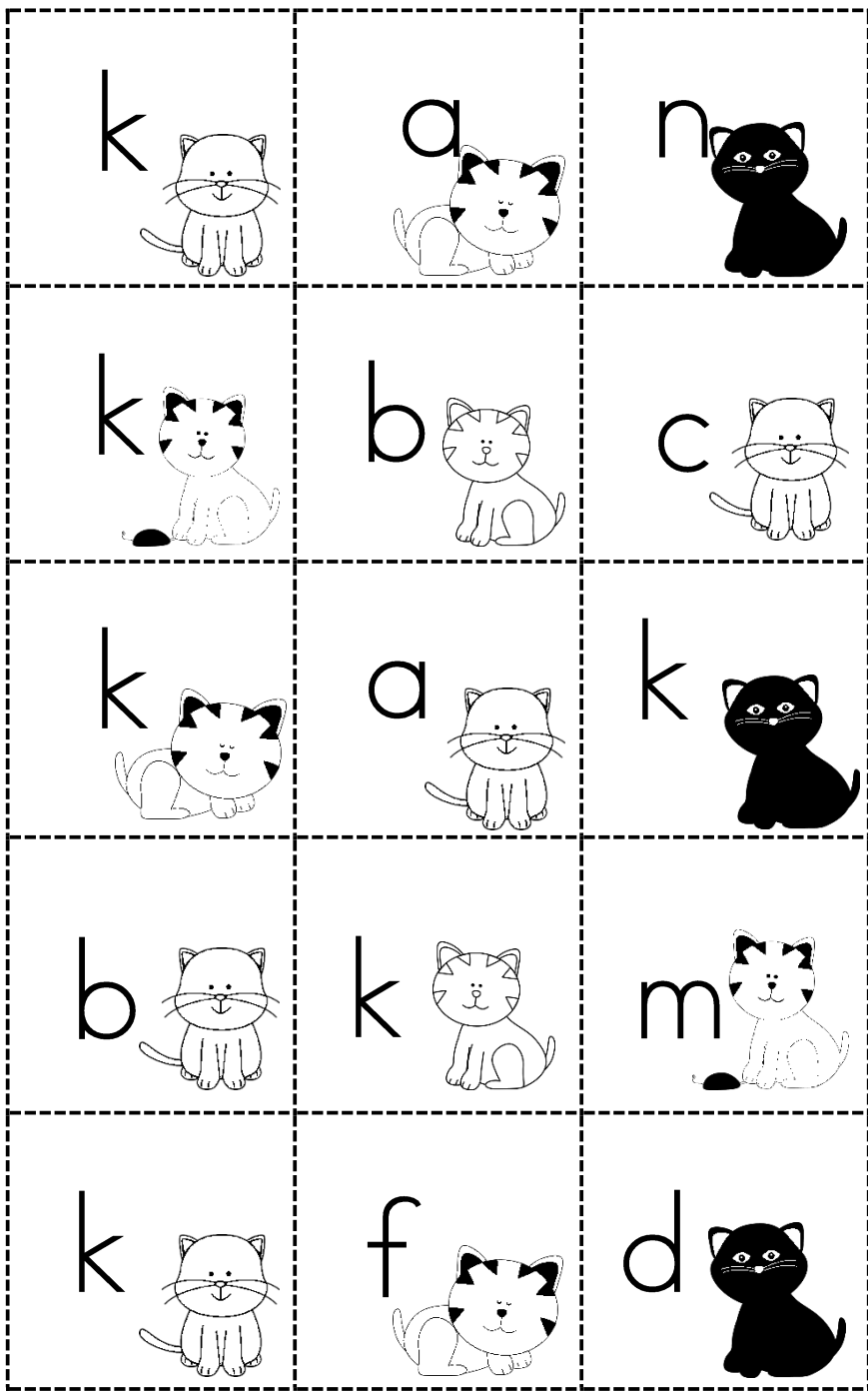


Letter K Crown: Cut out the crown. Cut and paste the pictures onto the crown. Staple a sentence strip or construction paper strip onto the crown to make a head band.

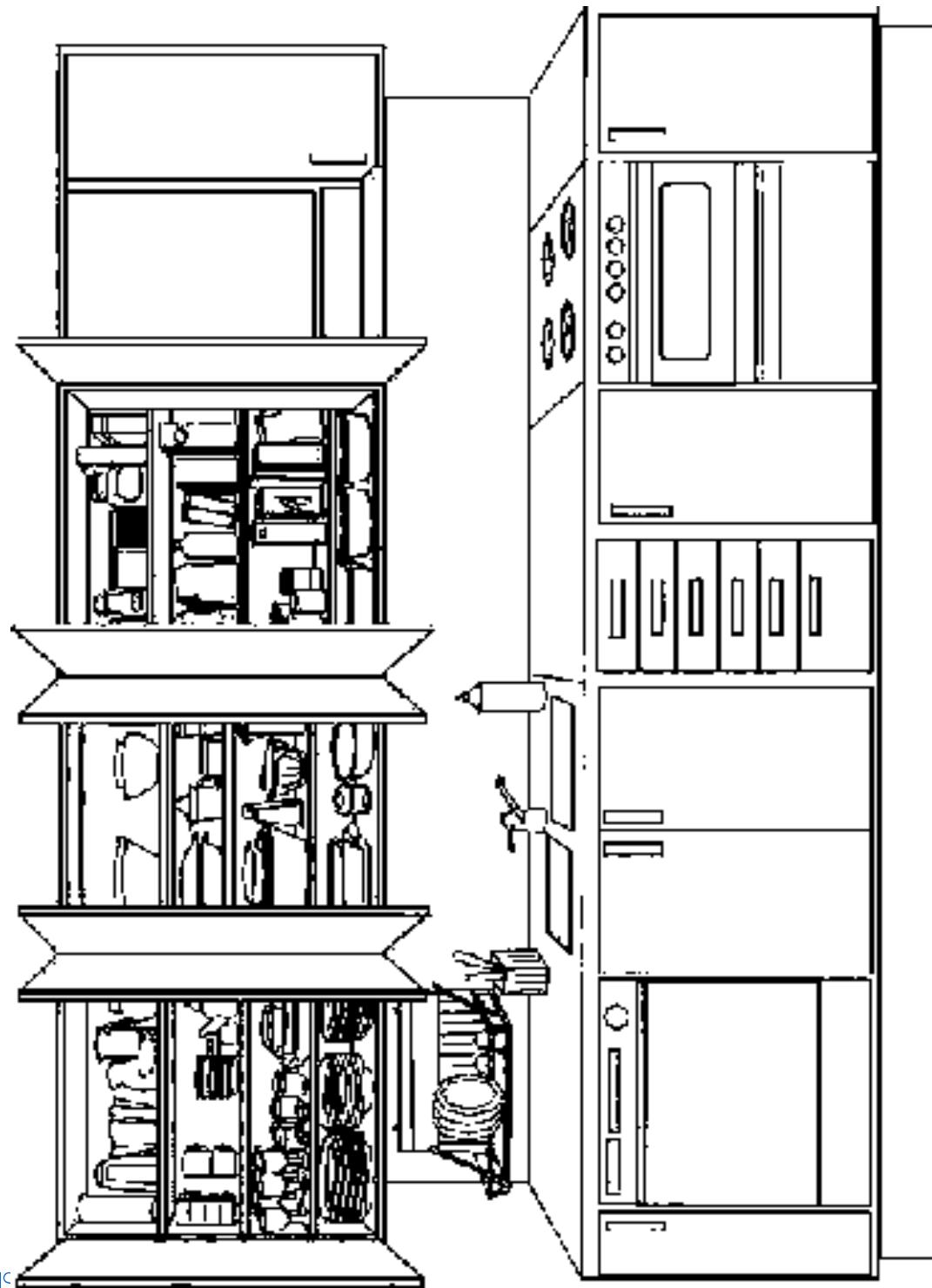

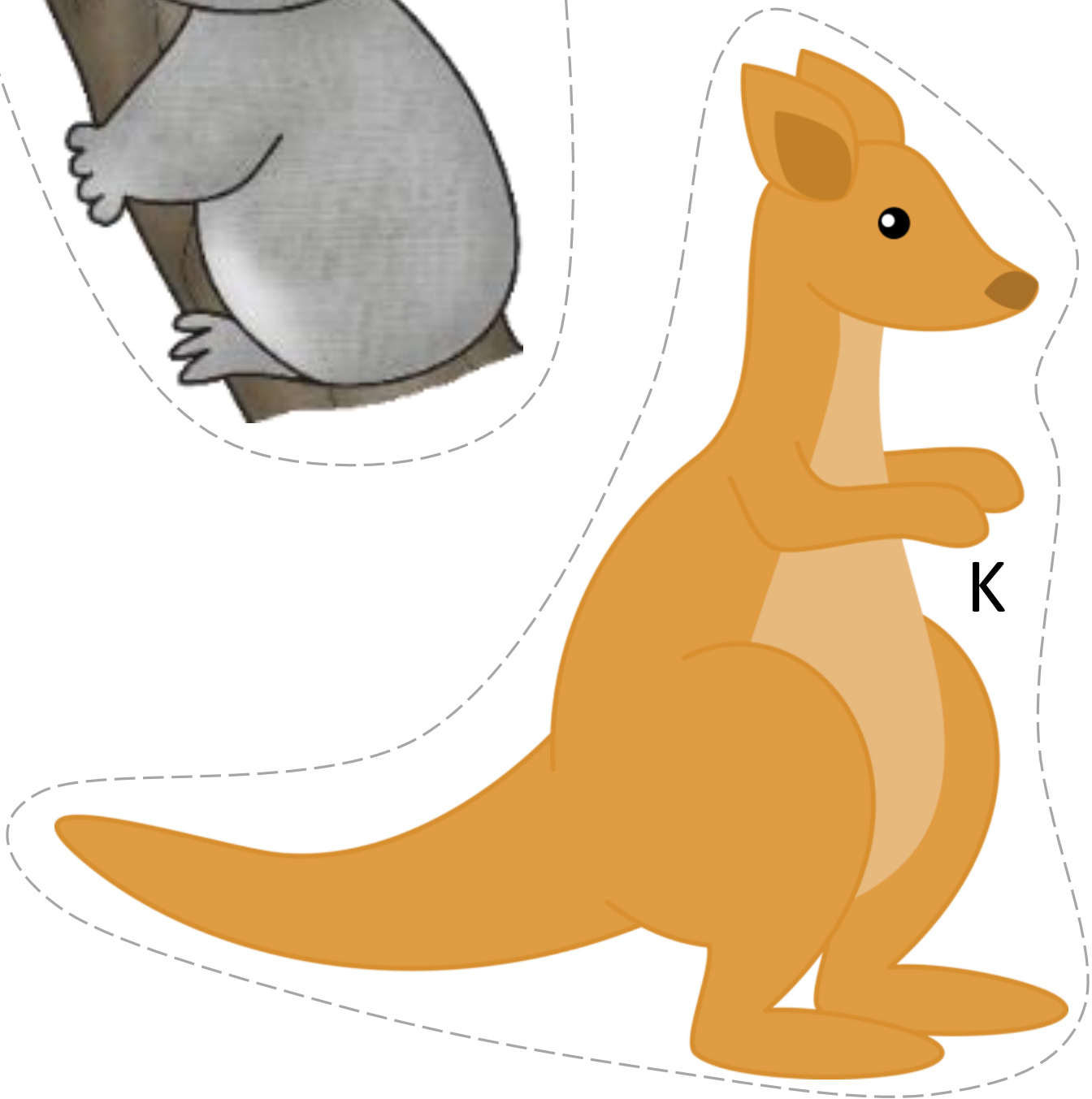
Play Dough Mat – Make some kittens to put on the blanket.

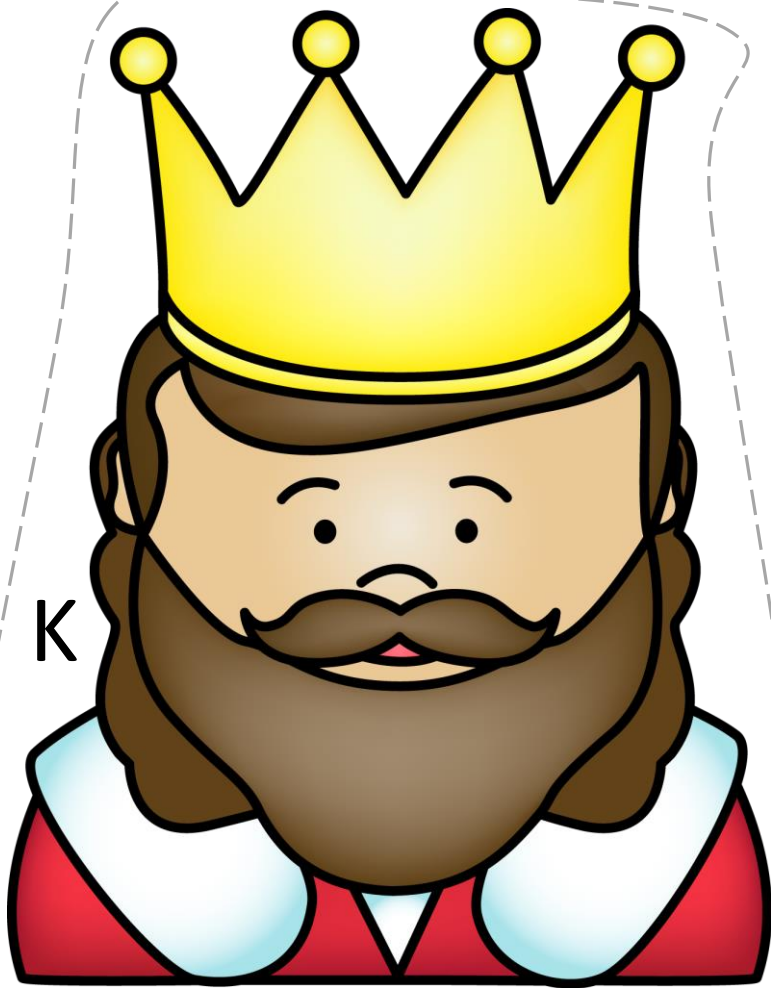
LACING CARD – Print on cardstock, and cut out. Punch holes around the edge. Children lace with yarn or a shoelace.



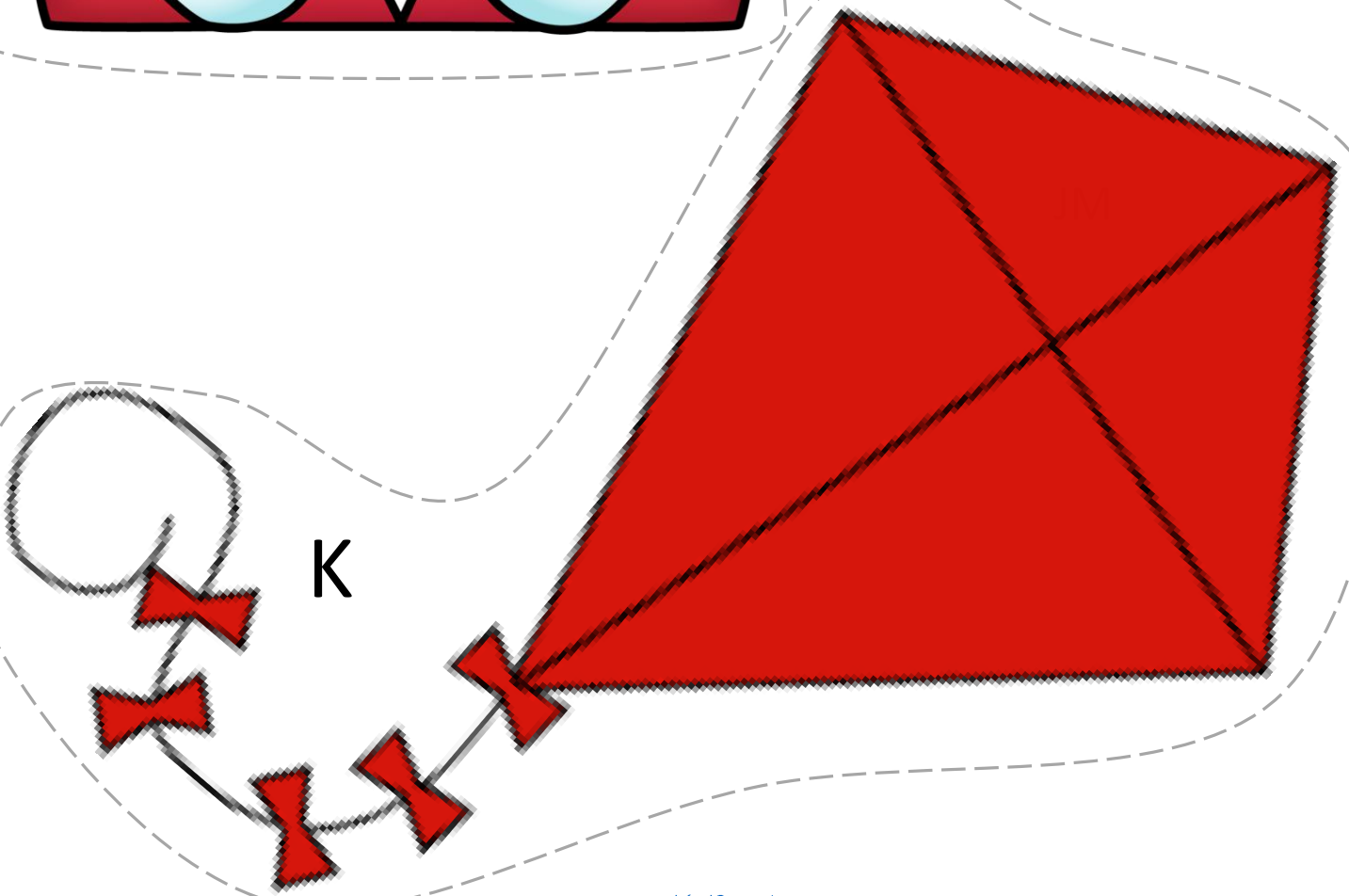
